- **Complete online application** (\$50 fee).

- **Meet application deadline(s):**

Fall July 1  
Winter December 1

- **Minimum GPA required:** 2.7 to 3.25  
(see specific requirements on the website).
- Submit **English proficiency test score(s)**.

- Applicants must have a **bachelor's degree** from a regionally accredited U.S. institution or an equivalent degree for international applicants.

- Submit **official transcripts** from all colleges and universities previously attended (including transcript evaluations from NACES-accredited organizations).

- **Additional documents** such as a resume, personal essay, and/or recommendation letters may be required based on student's application file.

**Deadline to submit documents for Fall I-20 is August 1, 2024.**

Students must meet minimum English proficiency, if not originating from an English-speaking country, and must meet the following minimum required scores:
