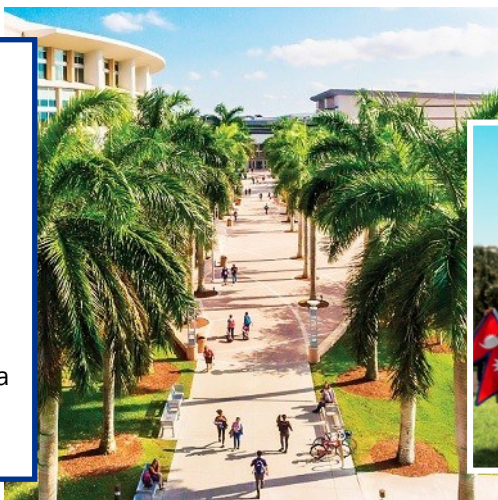

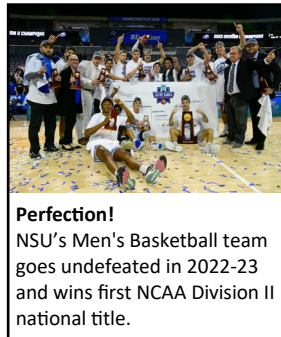
Living in South Florida

NSU's Men's Basketball team goes undefeated in 2022-23 and wins first NCAA Division II national title.

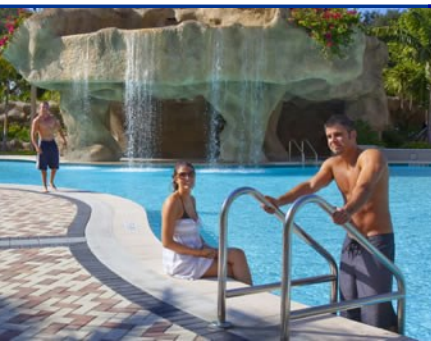

Residence Halls

Residence halls are spacious, secure and convenient to the recreation fitness complex, campus dining and classes. All residence halls offer free utilities including wi-fi, cable and laundry, and every room features a private bathroom. Undergraduate students with 0-48 credit hours are required to live on-campus. Freshman can choose from Leo Goodwin Sr. Hall, The Commons or the Cultural Living Center and single, double and triple rooms are available. UNDERGRADUATE REQUIREMENTS

- Complete online application (\$50 application fee). Applicants have two ways to apply:

- Application Deadlines: **July 1** for Fall applicants and **December 1** for Winter applicants
- Minimum GPA: 3.0 (varies for some programs)
- Academic Grades:
First time in College: High school grades translated to English by licensed translator
Transfer from foreign university: Course by course credential evaluation from NACES accredited organization. Link to accredited organizations: <https://www.naces.org/members>.
- English proficiency test score
- Students who have earned CXC or O-level certificates, HSC, BGCSE, and CAPE must provide five passing scores in academic subjects and proof of secondary school completion.
- SAT/ACT (optional)

Academic Performance Scholarships

NSU awards annual undergraduate scholarships between \$11,000 and \$21,000 and transfer scholarships between \$12,000 and \$20,000 to international undergraduate students based on academic performance. Scholarships are awarded at point of admission.
