Residence Halls

Residence halls are spacious, secure and convenient to the recreation fitness complex, campus dining and classes. All residence halls offer free utilities including wi-fi, cable and laundry, and every room features a private bathroom. Undergraduate students with 0-48 credit hours are required to live on-campus. • Complete online application. Applicants have two ways to apply:

Fee Waiver Information:

- 1. In the section, Application Fee Payment, answer "Yes" to the first section where it asks if you feel your financial circumstances might qualify you for an application fee waiver. Next, select the last option, "I can provide a supporting statement from a school official, college access counselor, financial aid officer, or community leader," and then type student's name into the Fee Waiver Signature field.
- 2. In the Order Summary section, enter promo code: UG-2026-rlcx4-120900, and click on Apply
- Application Deadlines: July 1 for Fall applicants and December 1 for Winter applicants
- Minimum GPA: 3.0 (varies for some programs)
- · Academic Grades:

<u>First time in College</u>: High school grades translated to English by licensed translator <u>Transfer from foreign university</u>: Course by course credential evaluation from NACES accredited organization. Link to accredited organizations: https://www.naces.org/members.

- English proficiency test score
- SAT or ACT or CLT test score (at least one score is required)
- Students who have earned CXC or O-level certificates, HSC, BGCSE, and CAPE must provide five passing scores in academic subjects and proof of secondary school completion.

Academic Performance Scholarships (Undergraduate)

NSU awards annual first-year undergraduate scholarships between \$5,000 and \$22,000 and transfer undergraduate scholarships between \$5,000 and \$20,000 to international students based on academic performance. Students submitting SAT scores of 1,200+ can earn an additional \$1,000 to \$2,000. Scholarships are awarded at point of admission.
